### Season 2025 is on the way



While it seems like no time at all since the 2024 Centenary year for the Tigers culminating in a magical dual premiership for the Mayne Seniors and Reserves, here we are again at the bottom of the mountain that is the 2025 season.

The Tiger hierarchy have been working solidly over the off season to date to make sure the club is ready for another year of combat on the field and that there is no premiership hangover.

The off field is largely set with the 2025 Committee finalised and operational with budgets set and agreed, season planning well underway and importantly coaching roles in place for all the teams. There are still a few positions to be filled but largely it is all systems go for another year in Tigerland and the first year of the club's second century.

We have been waiting patiently for the QFA Division 1 Draw to be finalised which was launched but sadly had to be revised almost immediately with the withdrawal of the Beenleigh Buffaloes. Unfortunately the Buffaloes have been struck by an exodus of their prime talent on the back of a very tough season. We all know how hard it is keep the momentum going to sustain a football club year after year so we very much empathise with their current dilemma. They came up to Division 1 in 2021 and immediately played in a grand final but have struggled to sustain the list required.

We wish them well for 2025 and look forward to them being a strong and competitive club again in the not too distant future.

This now means that Division 1 is restricted to seven teams being Caloundra, Hinterland, Mayne, Moreton Bay, University, Sandgate and Springwood.

The Season will kick off with an away game against Hinterland on the 12th April with sixteen fixtures making up the usual number of rounds.

Highlights will include a new adversary for Anzac Day being traditional rivals in the Sandgate Hawks. This game will be held at Lemke Road on the 26th April and will include all the usual ceremony and appropriate recognition commensurate with a day of this significance on the Australian calendar.

Reunion Day will once again be held on the last weekend of May being Saturday 31st May to recognise and award the Mick Nolan Medal. It will also highlight and mark the ten year anniversary of the 2015 Seniors and Reserves Premierships. In a quirk of the draw we will also play Sandgate on Reunion Day.

We will play eight home games with the final round being 23rd August with a home game against the Springwood Pumas. We will play Hinterland, University and Springwood three times and the other clubs twice. There will be a final four with the Grand Final to be held on Saturday 13th September.


The Tigers playing group are once again focussed on being the best they possibly can in the upcoming season as they work through the hot and steamy part of the year.

pleasing aspect has been the local talent which has underpinned the club. The 2024 grand final teams included 28 Mayne and Everton Juniors out of the 44 premiership players.

It also included a further three Aspley, two Ferny Grove and two Sandgate Juniors to make 35 of the 44 as local talent.

It follows that the Tigers are focussed on providing as many opportunities for local youth as possible to keep the pathway strong.

### 2025 Anzac Day Clash

The Tigers have enjoyed a historic and nostalgic period from 2018 to 2024 playing traditional rivals Coorparoo in an Anzac Day game which had become an important event on the calendar for both clubs.

The best player in the Anzac Day game was awarded a Wayne Stewart Medal to honour the famous player of both clubs and it was a much coveted award by all the players.

The Coorparoo Football Club have now returned to the QAFL and as such the Tigers will no longer play them in 2025.

A new development for the 2025 Season sees the Sandgate Hawks promoted to QFA Division 1. As a consequence of this development, the Tigers and the Hawks have agreed to play an annual Anzac Day game as traditional rivals from days gone by. Mayne and Sandgate fought out some mighty and occasionally ferocious Grand Finals in the 1970's which many dedicated footy followers will remember fondly.





The Anzac Day game for 2025 will be played at Lemke Road and alternated year on year between the Den and Sandgate.

The Tigers and the Hawks have also decided that they will play for an annual Mayne Sandgate Anzac

Day Perpetual Trophy and also a Medal will be awarded to the Best Player on the day selected by the competing coaches.

The Medal will recognise a player from each club who exemplified the 1970's era where these two great clubs fought out some of their titanic battles. Each player has an extraordinary record for their respective clubs and indeed Queensland Football for this period.

Mayne have selected Paul Meakin and Sandgate have selected John Stackpoole as the two players for the naming of the medal.

Paul Meakin's summary record is as follows.

### **Reunion Day 2025**

The Annual Reunion Day has become a very important day for the Tigers growing in importance and support every year.

The 2024 Reunion Day was particularly special with the Centenary Year celebrations being added to the weekend. It was the biggest and best attended event for the club for decades.

This year the club will not only award the Mick Nolan Medal but will also recognise and celebrate the anniversary of the 2015 Mayne Seniors and Reserves Premiership wins which were part of a three peat for both grades through 2014-2016.

It will be held on Saturday 31st May 2025 at the Den with the club playing Sandgate this year.

It is anticipated that former players, friends and supporters will attend from all around Australia.

The Mick Nolan Medal was struck in 2008 on the passing of the much loved Mayne Premiership Coach and North Melbourne Premiership player and has been awarded every year since.



#### **New Coaches Boxes for Oval 2**

The Mayne Tigers and Everton Wolves have been working together to extend the project that included the construction of the Timekeepers and Medical Building as well as the Scoreboard to include new coaches boxes for Oval 2.

These new structures also include storage capacity for equipment used on game day such as temporary goal posts, goal pads, shade structures and other items. It is a considerable help to volunteers to have these items closer to the ground on game day to save the time and effort carrying them up to the equipment shed.

This is another example of the two clubs working together to achieve improved facilities. The Joint Facilities Committee is also working on a further grant application to install additional improvements to the Timekeepers and Medical Building with a shade extension and insulation.
