The Tigers fielded a strong outfit this week with only a couple of their best unavailable but the Kings were missing a few as well making for an exciting pre-match build up.

However, despite all the preparation the Kings flew out of the blocks with four unanswered goals as the Tigers worked desperately to match the pace and precise skills

being displayed by the home team. The Kings speedster Shayle Korander drew first blood while goal kicking specialist Joshua Ferguson kicked two to have the Tigers well on the back foot.

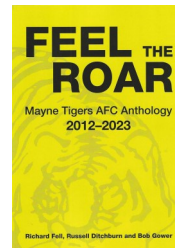

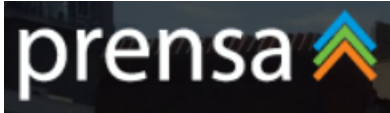
